We look forward to partnering with you for the upcoming 2023 – 2024 school year. We have a full line-up of classes and are excited to offer more core and elective courses. For the upcoming school year, tuition costs remain the same and the family fee increased by \$10.

The family fee is non-refundable. If you choose FACTS, the family fee must be paid separately. You have 72 hours to make changes to your student’s schedule or withdraw and receive a refund for class fees. After 72 hours, class fees are non-refundable, and no changes can be made to a student’s schedule.

Family Fee is assessed at the time of registration. Family Fee and Classes must be paid within 14 days from date of submission. If arrangements or payment have not been received, then your student(s) will be dropped from the registration process, and you will have to re-register.

General Information

- 8th Grade Students may take the following classes: ASL 1, Art I, General Science, Geography, Grammar & Language Arts, Guitar, Physical Science, Spanish I, Western Civilization, Music, Child and Human Development, and Math according to level tested.
- English 2 is a pre-requisite for most Cornerstone English/Literature classes.
- All Math Classes require completion of a pre-test (or a passing grade in a previous Cornerstone math class)

- Courses may have a copy/materials fee in addition to tuition that is paid directly to the tutor. Please check with each tutor to see their requirements.

Prerequisites

- American Literature – 10th grade and up, Elements of Composition & Literature
- American Government – 11th grade and up, U.S. History
- Biology – 9th grade and up, Physical Science
- British Literature – 10th grade and up, English 2
- Chemistry – Algebra 1, Physical Science, Biology
- College and Research – 11th grade and up, English 2, and completion of either American Literature or British Literature
- Photography Editing – completion or currently taking photography/yearbook, no phone photos.
- Physics – Algebra 1, Geometry, Chemistry
- Spanish 2 – Spanish 1 with a grade of C or better
- U.S. History – 10th grade and up, English 2
- English 2 – English 1 or instructor permission
- ASL 2 – ASL 1 with a grade of C or better
- Life and Earth Science – 9th grade and above
- Pre-Calculus – Algebra 2
- Psychology – 9th grade and above or completion of Child/Human Development
- Intro to Theology – 10th grade and above
