Family Fee is assessed at the time of registration. Family Fee and Classes must be paid within 14 days from date of submission. If arrangements or payment have not been received, then your student(s) will be dropped from the registration process, and you will have to re-register.

General Information

- 8th Grade Students may take the following classes: ASL 1, Art I, General Science, Geography, English 1, Guitar, Physical Science, Spanish I, Western Civilization, Music, and Math according to level tested.
- English 2 is a prerequisite for most Cornerstone English/Literature classes.
- All Math Classes require completion of a pre-test (or a passing grade in a previous Cornerstone math class)
- Courses may have a copy/materials fee in addition to tuition that is paid directly to the tutor. Please check with each tutor to see their requirements.
